Expectations

- Read and Review **ALL** requirements prior to the class
Even though a requirement may be identified as one to be done in class, Scouts are still expected to familiarize, review, and prepare for the requirement – BE PREPARED!
- Active interaction/participation is expected and mandatory.
- Share in your own words – avoid reading your answers.
- Pay attention to the action verbs.
- Bring proof of completion (even partially completed work)

Requirements	Expectations
1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bring your completed write-up to the class • Be prepared for class discussion by reading the Declaration of Independence prior to attending the class.
2, 3, 5, and 6	<p>If you have prepared ahead of time, you will be able to complete these requirements during the class.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Time will be allotted for those Scouts who have prepared to share their work for sign off consideration
4	<p>Successfully fulfilling this requirement during the class is contingent upon having completed at least one of the two option for Requirement 4 beforehand and bringing your work to class.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The instructor / counselor will facilitate completion of at least one of the two requirement options during the class.
