REQUIREMENT 5 A 3: Explain how you can make enough of the product or perform the service to meet your goals.

REQUIREMENT 5 A 5: Determine what type of license, if any, you might need in order to sell or make your product or service.

REQUIREMENT 5 B: Market Analysis

REQUIREMENT 5 B 1: Identify the types of people who would buy your product or service.

REQUIREMENT 5 B 2: Identify your business's competitors, and describe their strengths and weaknesses.

REQUIREMENT 5 B 3: Describe what makes your product or service unique.

REQUIREMENT 5 C: Financial

REQUIREMENT 5 C 1: Determine how much money you will need to start your business, and identify how you will obtain the money.

REQUIREMENT 5 C 2: Determine the cost of offering your product or service and the price you will charge in order to make a profit.

REQUIREMENT 5 C 3: Describe what will happen with the money you make from the sales of your product or service.

REQUIREMENT 5 D: Personnel

REQUIREMENT 5 D 1: Determine what parts of the business you will handle yourself, and describe your qualifications.

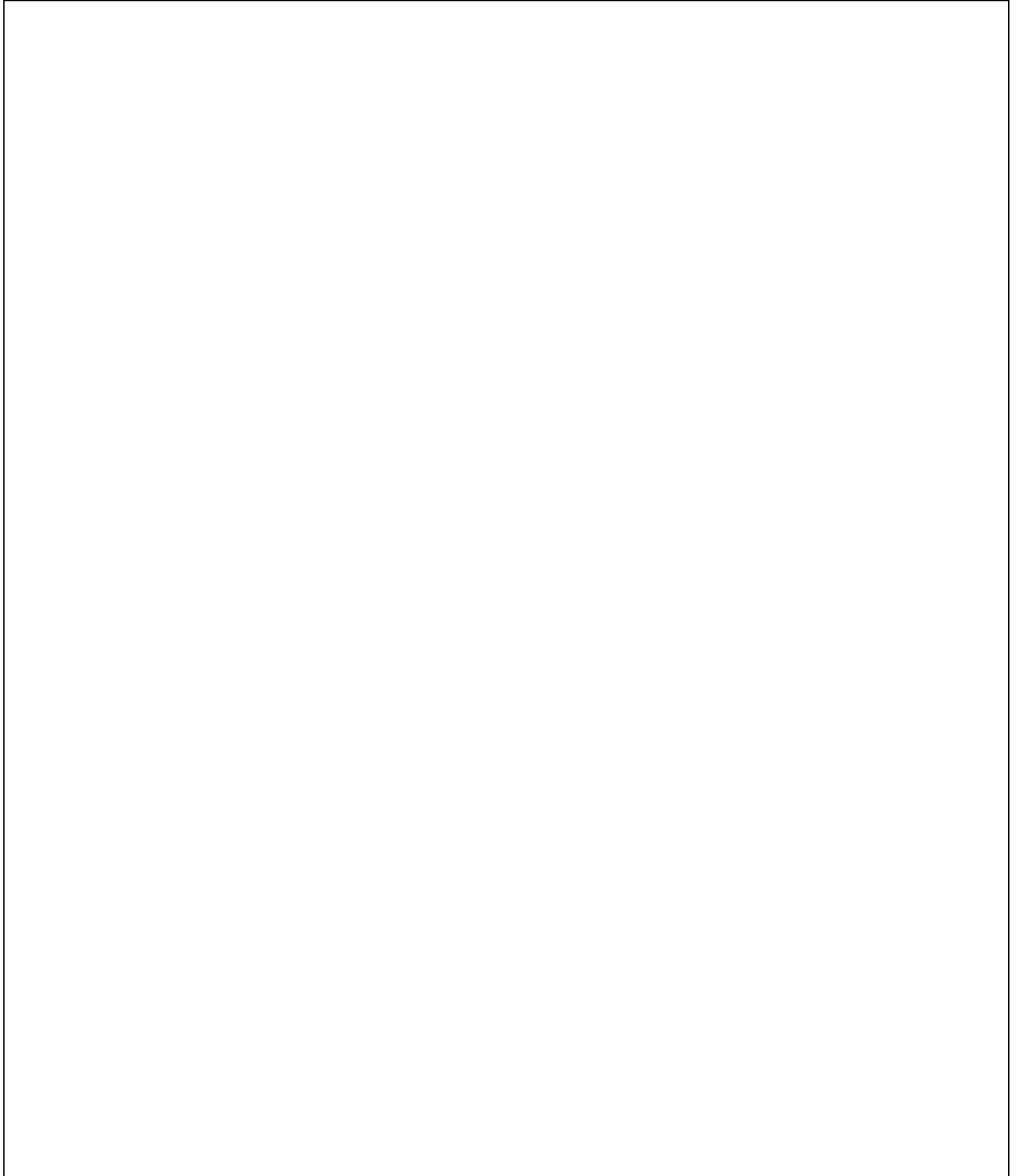
