



Pay attention to the action verbs.

Bring proof of completion (even partially completed work)

1a	<ul> <li>This requirement is easy to prepare for, simply go the link below, with your parent or guardian's permission, and view the video prior to the class.</li> <li>https://www.scouting.org/training/youth/scouts-bsa/ choose the Digital Safety option</li> <li>This video will NOT be played as a part of the class.</li> <li>At the discretion and kindness of the instructor / counselor this video MAY be played if time allows after the class, but this should not be expected.</li> </ul>
1b, 2, 3, 4, and 6	<ul> <li>If you have prepared ahead of time, you will be able to successfully complete these requirements and requirement components during the class.</li> <li>Time will be allotted for those Scouts who have prepared to share their work for sign off consideration</li> </ul>
5	<ul> <li>This requirement will need to be done prior to the class.</li> <li>While the instructor / counselor will be able to help give guidance and insight to enhance a Scout's programming knowledge, THIS IS NOT AN INTRODUCTORY CODING CLASS.</li> </ul>
