Expectations

- Read and Review **ALL** requirements prior to the class
Even though a requirement may be identified as one to be done in class, Scouts are still expected to familiarize, review, and prepare for the requirement – BE PREPARED!
- Active interaction/participation is expected and mandatory.
- Share in your own words – avoid reading your answers.
- Pay attention to the action verbs.
- Bring proof of completion (even partially completed work)

Requirements	Expectations
1, 2, 3, 5, 7, and 8	<p>If you have prepared ahead of time, you will be able to successfully complete these requirements during the class.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Time will be allotted for those Scouts who have prepared to share their work for sign off consideration
4	<p>For sign off consideration during the class, Scouts will need to come prepared and ready to share or present their work for this requirement.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Choose one of the components 4a, 4b, or 4c to complete for Requirement 4. • Scouts will have an opportunity to share their work during the class for sign off consideration.
6	<p>Scouts desiring to get signed off on this requirement during class will need to bring with them their collection of Scouting patches or memorabilia.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Don't forget that you will also need to be ready to share information about your collection with the class and counselor.
