#### **Expectations**

Read and Review ALL requirements prior to the class Even though a requirement may be identified as one to be done in class, Scouts are still expected to familiarize, review, and prepare for the requirement – BE PREPARED!

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# Wood Carving Merit Badge

### **Requirements Insight**

**NOTE:** Scouts **MUST** have their current Totin' Chip with them in order to participate in the class. There will **NOT** be any instruction to earn this as a part of the class. Scouts need to have earned their Totin' Chip **PRIOR** to attending the class. And don't forget to bring your pocketknife as well.

WARNING: Due to the high safety risk during this merit badge class, Scouts not following directions or failing to adhere to the class instructions WILL be removed from the class and forfeit participation fees and the privilege of continuing to participate for the rest of the event day. The instructor's / counselor's word is final. Parent / Guardian will be required to remove their Scout from the event venue immediately.

1, 2b, 3, and 5	<ul> <li>If you have prepared ahead of time, you will be able to complete these requirements and requirement components during the class.</li> <li>Time will be allotted for those Scouts who have prepared to share their work for sign off consideration.</li> </ul>
2a	<ul> <li>The earning of the Totin' Chip will NOT be a part of the class.</li> <li>Scouts need to have their current Totin' Chip card with them in order to participate in the class.</li> <li>NO EXCEPTIONS and NO ACCOMMODATIONS!</li> </ul>
4, 5, 6, and 7	<ul> <li>Be aware that there is some level of skill required for these requirements.</li> <li>Scouts must bring their wood blocks to class to share and use during the class discussion.</li> <li>The instructor / counselor will help facilitate the project work and coach technique and skill development during the class.</li> <li>No guarantee of completion is promised or implied as each of these requirements require a level of skill, which may not be able to be reached to a level, in order to complete.</li> <li>Additionally, while the majority of the class will focus on project work, it cannot be guaranteed that Scouts will finish their project work within the allotted class time.</li> </ul>
