#### **Expectations**

Read and Review ALL requirements prior to the class Even though a requirement may be identified as one to be done in class, Scouts are still expected to familiarize, review, and prepare for the requirement – BE PREPARED!

Active interaction/participation is expected and mandatory.

Share in your own words – avoid reading your answers.

Pay attention to the action verbs.

Bring proof of completion (even partially completed work)



### Things to Remember to Bring

- 2. Scout Uniform
- 3. Notes and Questions from reading the Woodwork Merit Badge Pamphlet

- 5. Wood Block samples for Requirement 2b
- 6. Supporting documentation or project work pertinent to this merit badge which may also include a Merit Badge Workbook for reference with notes.
- 7. A positive Scouting focus and attitude

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# **Woodwork Merit Badge**

#### **Requirements Insight**

**NOTE:** Scouts **MUST** have their current Totin' Chip with them in order to participate in the class. There will **NOT** be any instruction to earn this as a part of the class. Scouts need to have earned their Totin' Chip **PRIOR** to attending the class.

WARNING: Due to the high safety risk during this merit badge class, Scouts not following directions or failing to adhere to the class instructions WILL be removed from the class and forfeit participation fees and the privilege of continuing to participate for the rest of the event day. The instructor's / counselor's word is final. Parent / Guardian will be required to remove their Scout from the event venue immediately.

Requirements	Expectations
1a, 1b, and 2a	<ul><li>If you have prepared ahead of time, you will be able to complete these requirement components during the class.</li><li>Time will be allotted for those Scouts who have prepared to share their work for sign off consideration.</li></ul>
1c	<ul> <li>The earning of the Totin' Chip will NOT be a part of the class.</li> <li>Scouts need to have their current Totin' Chip card with them in order to participate in the class.</li> <li>NO EXCEPTIONS and NO ACCOMMODATIONS!</li> </ul>
2b	Scouts must bring their wood blocks to class to share and use during the class discussion.
3, 4, 5, 6, and 7	<ul> <li>Be sure to review the merit badge pamphlet for a more comprehensive understanding on these requirement components.</li> <li>The instructor / counselor will facilitate these requirements during the class.</li> </ul>

Merit Badge Workbooks are a tool to aid Scouts with their work preparation. BSA discourages but does not ban — the use of any merit badge worksheets or workbooks. Merit badge counselors must NEVER require the use of merit badge worksheets or workbooks and may if they choose, refuse to accept them. Scouts shall not be required to use ANY of these to complete a merit badge.
